

# Floor Care

### **Description**

A natural breathable milky polish for surfaces coated with The Natural Paint Company varnishes, waxes and oils and other similar coatings. Biodegradable and fast drying, The Natural Paint Company Floor Care forms a silky, anti-slip satin finish which enhances and protects the surface from both dirt and mechanical wear. Regular use will prolong the life of the surface coating. Floor Care contains no chemical preservatives, chlorides, ammonia or phosphates.

### Uses

To refresh and maintain oiled, waxed and varnished interiors including:

- Timber surfaces
- Linoleum
- Cork
- Terracotta tiles
- Concrete

### **Container Sizes**

• 1 Litre, 2 Litre, 5 Litre

### **Ingredients**

Water, carnauba wax, microwax, fatty acid alcohol-ester, lavender oil, bergamot oil (contains limonene).

#### **Applying the Product**

- 1. Use only when varnish, oil or wax is well hardened wait at least 4 weeks after final coating.
- 2. Clean area first. Use a gentle, non-abrasive pH neutral cleaner. We recommend The Natural Paint Company Household Cleaner.
- 3. Spot clean again where necessary.
- 4. Apply Floor Care thinly and evenly with a lint free cloth or floor mop/sponge. Use at a rate of 100-150mls to 5 litres of lukewarm water.
- 5. Frequency of application depends on the substrate and wear.

**Note**: The Natural Paint Company Floor Care might change the sheen level, surface appearance and characteristics of some finishes. Apply to a test piece or area first to establish suitability of the treated surface.
